Residents of the Schenectady City School District, who are eligible for transportation to non-public schools under the revised Transportation Policy adopted February 11, 1992 are required to file an application for transportation in accordance with Chapter 3635 of the New York State Laws of 1960.

Transportation is provided for students in grades <u>K-5</u> who attend schools that <u>are MORE than 1.0 but LESS than 5.5</u> miles from their legal residence and for students in Grades <u>6-12</u> who attend schools that are <u>MORE than 1.5 but LESS than 5.5 miles</u> from their legal residence.
