- Implement restorative justice practices and uphold expectations for scholar behavior and social-emotional growth
- Teaches knowledge and skills in physical fitness, health education, and individual, dual, or team sports to primary students, utilizing a course of study adopted by the School District and/or site.
- Assess each student's progress in physical fitness, skills and knowledge; prepare, document and communicate progress reports to students, parents, and school administration

- Works cooperatively with administration and staff in planning a balanced physical education program, adapting daily schedules to accommodate weather conditions and to provide time for transitions, instruction, exercise, and sports activities.



- Execute lesson plans with differentiation in order to ensure 100% of scholars reach and exceed their year-long academic goals
- Script and rehearse clear directions and routines for scholars to ensure a positive and inclusive classroom environment
- Use data informed practices to drive instruction and ensure all academic gaps are closed for all scholars
- Collaboration and co-planning with co-teacher and special education teachers to plan lessons, assess scholars, and interpret performance data

- Execution of all classroom systems supporting the Positive Recognition System
- Communicate and partner effectively with diverse populations of students, families, and staff
- Assist with operational support of various school-wide systems to ensure safety and efficiency of scholar arrival, dismissal, and transitions
- Provides appropriate safety instruction and makes safety checks on equipment and field areas to ensure the over-all safety of students
